Activity Report 2020

Swiss Music Export's activities in 2020 were dominated by two themes: One was **EUROSONIC 2020** in **Groningen NL**, where Switzerland was the focus country and SME had the role of presenting and representing Switzerland, coordinating the selection of artists, and supporting many current and future collaborations of Swiss music companies with international partners. We believe it was a complete success and therefore show you in this annual report mainly pictures from these crazy three days in January 2020.

The other issue in 2020 was this «monster» called Corona, which brought the world to a standstill, especially the music sphere, which is particularly characterised by human interaction, meeting and usually also by travelling. We cannot quantify how much 2020 did NOT happen. However, we in Switzerland can count ourselves lucky to have built up a network in cooperation with numerous associations and institutions, which has been able to carry cultural professionals through this crisis, at least in good part. Spontaneously, we realigned our business support as «STARTING OVER». We would like to thank our partners for the fact that we were all able to pull together and rapidly support the music world in a new way. And we would like to thank the musicians for continuing to produce great music in 2020, under adverse circumstances.

This annual report is a special one; therefore also short and concise.

Eurosonic ESNS 2020: «A TASTE OF SWISS MUSIC»



Groningen, 15 - 18 January 2020: The project took several years to complete, as the preparatory activities (inviting industry experts and journalists to Switzerland, as well as networking events) began as early as 2018. The festival in January 2020 was one of the highlights in the history of Swiss (indie) pop music.

Shortly after the festival, almost all the live acts drew a consistently positive balance and were immediately able to show some festival bookings for the coming summer and autumn, which was also visible in the ETEP ranking. Unfortunately, the pandemic threw a spanner in the works. We hope that most of the concerts were postponed until after the pandemic.


